Each of the following forms must be completed and filed on time by independent candidates for office of President and Vice President of the United States in order for the candidates' names to be placed on the ballot for the November 6, 2012 General Election in Wisconsin.

- Circulate and submit Nomination Papers (Form GAB-167) to the Government Accountability Board by 5:00 p.m., on Tuesday, August 7, 2012. Nomination papers may not be circulated before July 1, 2012. §8.20, Wis. Stats.

- Complete and submit a *Declaration of Candidacy* (Form GAB-162) to the Government Accountability Board by **5:00 p.m., on Tuesday, August 7, 2012**.** This form must be filed with the Government Accountability Board by August 7, 2012, or the candidates' names will not be placed on the ballot. §8.20(6), 8.21, Wis. Stats.
